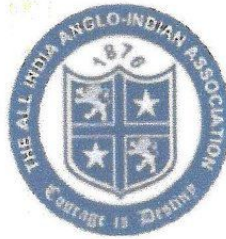

Dear Members,

As per our commitment to the Community we extended a helping hand to all those members who approached us during the month of August 2020 with a hamper of dry rations for families in need during the month. We shall maintain confidentiality for the dignity of our members and to assist them discreetly in this time of special need.

Few members have approached us to commence collection of subscriptions for the current financial year, which we had deferred expecting the AGM to be held sometime before September 2020. With the AGM not being held now (refer to H.O. letter dated 11 August 2020) the Branch Committee met on 03 September 2020 and decided to commence collection of subscriptions for the year April 2020 to March 2021. This may be remitted to either the Treasurer, the Secretary or to me at your convenience by cash or cheque. Ensure that you collect a printed receipt immediately for this transaction.

The *Memorandum and Articles of Association* of The All-India Anglo-Indian Association stipulates in Article 13. "A member shall cease to be a member of the Association" (iii) "when his dues to the Association are equivalent to six months' subscription." In accordance with this article all members who have not paid subscription for the year commencing April 2020 shall cease to be members of the Branch on **30 September 2020**.

We appeal to our youth (and their parents) who have attained the age of 15 years to enrol as members (JSM) of the Branch as soon as possible to maintain the healthy traditions of our Community which we collectively are striving to uphold for the past few years.

Head Office has remitted to the Branch ₹ 32000/- to be disbursed to the Senior Citizens of the Branch who applied for financial assistance for the year 2018-2019. This is being handed over to the applicants during the next few days. Applications for 2019-2020 are still to be processed by Head Office. May God in His infinite kindness continue to protect us from this pandemic and its consequences.
