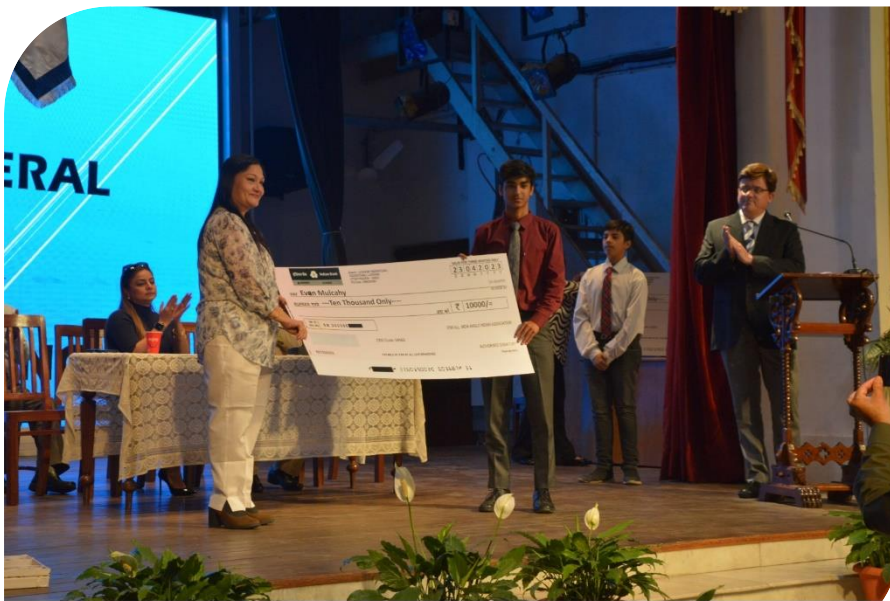


Ms Charmaine Fanthome received the Life time achievement award, awarded posthumously to her father Dr Peter Fanthome.

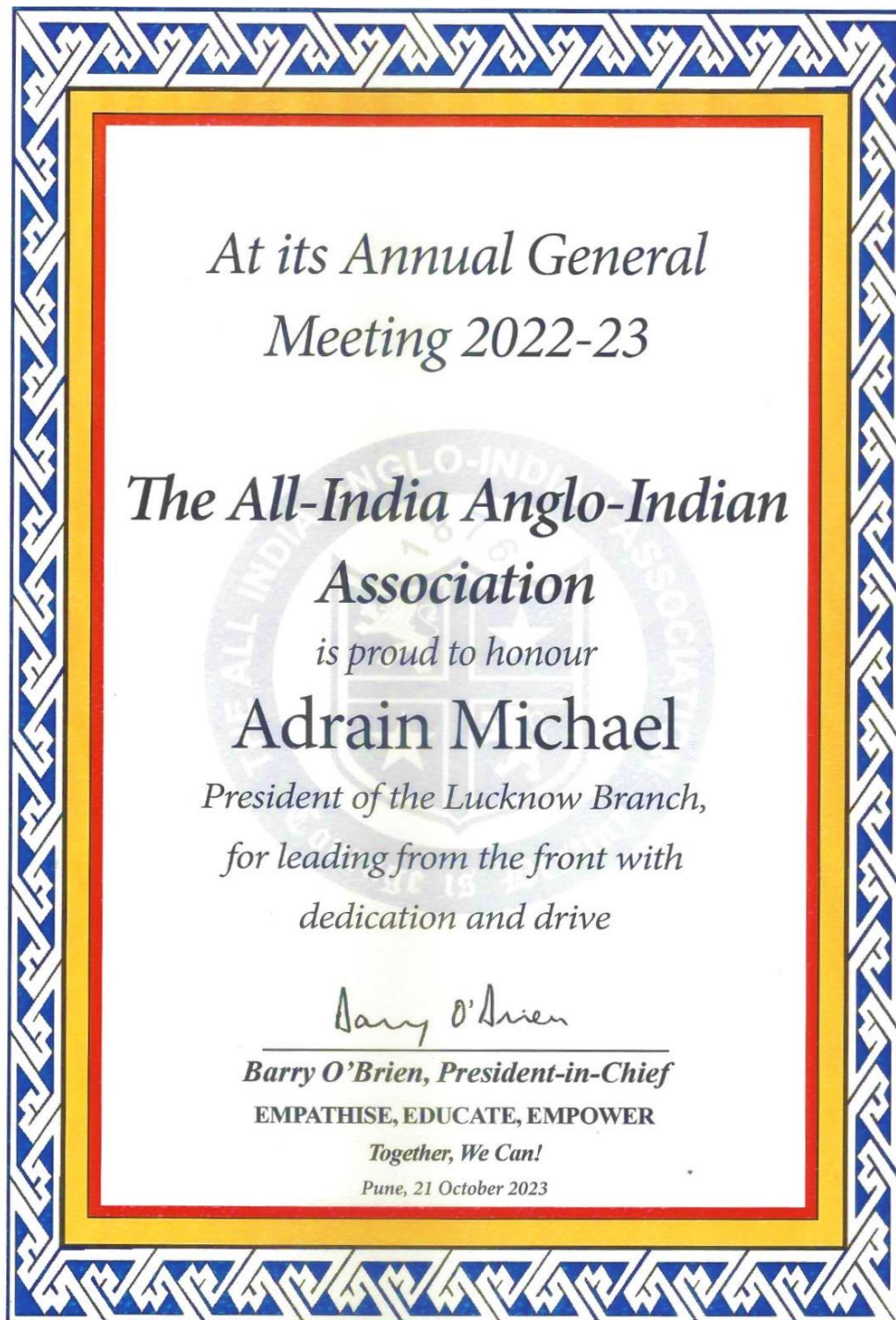
June - 2023

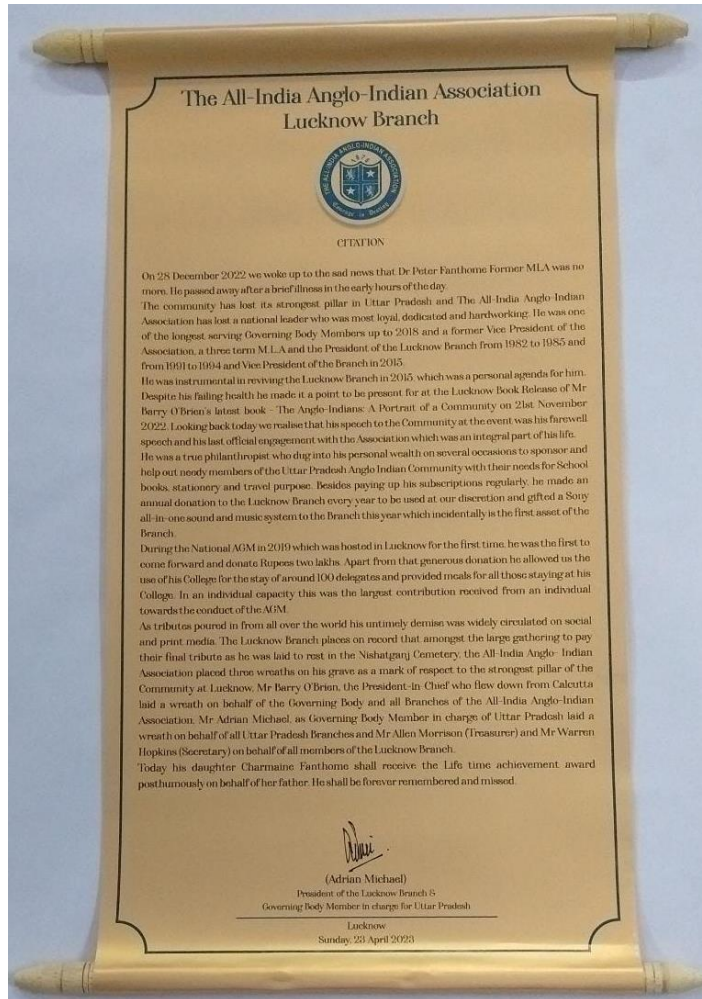

Registration Fee

Most of the Get-together conducted by the Lucknow Branch are free for members which include gifts, snacks, liquor, beverages and sumptuous Non-vegetarian meals. Despite this there is no way to ensure participation, which generally results in wastage of food and other items. Hence the Branch Committee unanimously decided to charge a token registration amount for all further Get-togethers. The token amount charged is to ensure participation so that wastage can be avoided in future.

For the information of all concerned the token amount collected as registration fee, does not even cover the cost for snacks at the gathering. Our usual format is Non-veg starters, beverages hot and cold, free tickets, complementary gifts and hampers at Housie and Non Veg menu for meals. Liquor Licenses

All programmes where liquor is served is done in compliance with the law. A liquor licence is purchased @ Rs 11000/- for each event and the liquor is served free-of-cost to all members above the age of 21 years. The cost of these licences are borne by individual members of the Branch Committee and this amount was not borne by the Branch or the members during this financial year.






